# **Winter Weather Policy**

When snow storms are predicted...visit www.npenn.org or watch NPTV (Comcast Cable channel 28 and Verizon Fios channel 29). If the schools are closed, the NPESC Program will not operate. If a one hour delayed opening occurs, the before school program will begin at 8:00 a.m. at each elementary school. If a two hour delayed opening occurs, the before school program will begin at 9:00 a.m. at each elementary school. If a three hour delayed opening occurs, the before school program will begin at 10:00 a.m. at each elementary school. If weather conditions worsen and schools close early, parents will receive a reminder call via the school messenger system to note that the NPESC program will close two hours after school dismissal.
