Al Brodhag Memorial Scholarship

Alfred Brodhag taught at North Penn High School for 31 years. During his life, he was an incredible example of good character and strong leadership.

Al served his country as an officer during the Korean War and was awarded the Commendation Medal. Prior to his military service, he had a remarkable athletic career at the University of Delaware, where he was the first All-American Catcher in U of D history, graduating in 1952 with the 2nd highest batting average in the nation.

He came to North Penn as a Health and PE teacher and was the Head Football Coach from 1962-70. He laid the groundwork and helped build the football program into the winning program it is today. He was also the Assistant Baseball Coach from 1959-1981. He was inducted into the NPAAA Hall of Fame in 2005.

He enjoyed being with his family, singing bass, and model railroading.
