Selection Criteria:

This scholarship award, in the amount of \$1200 total, will be awarded to (2) students, with \$600 given to each student scholarship winner, who share and best exemplify the same or similar traits and character that Daniel did in his life – kindness to others, courage and bravery in the face of challenges and hope and perseverance in the face of those challenges.

To apply for this scholarship, please provide the following:

- An essay or letter that demonstrates how the student/applicant displays: kindness to others, courage in the face of challenges, and maintaining hope and a positive outlook for their future while facing these challenges.
- 2. The student/applicant may submit 1 to 3 letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or member of the North Penn Community.

Applicants who accept this scholarship award are expected to use these funds to pursue post high school educational/vocational goals.

In the event that there is only one applicant that fulfills the criteria of the scholarship or there are not enough qualified submissions, the scholarship will then be awarded to that single deserving and qualified applicant in the amount of \$1200.

The essay/letter and/or any letters of recommendation will be reviewed by the Forte Family and the scholarship will be awarded to the (2) students based on their assessment.
