Mrs. Simpson often volunteered to assist both the North Penn High School Band, Chorus, and Theatre programs as a parent volunteer where her son, Jackson, attended and graduated (Class of 2015).

Kristi's relentless support of students passionately pursuing the arts at North Penn was the underlying inspiration for this award. This scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis to the graduating senior who will be pursuing a college major in band, music or theatre and who most embodies Kristi's passion for self-exploration, leadership and community service.

- A North Penn High School senior who has committed to or whose intention is to attend a college, university, or conservatory and major in the performing arts (instrumental, voice, and/or theatre).

3. A typed, 250-500 word essay on the importance of leadership and how service to others impacts our community, with examples of how you have served your community.
4. A typed, 250-500 word essay on how music and/or theatre has shaped your life and inspired you to choose music and/or theatre as a college major.
